All mares must have a halter or neckstrap with HER name on it. Mares presented to the breeding shed without proper identification will not be bred. Please make additional copies of this shed form. Check the appropriate category for mare and attach necessary paperwork. This form must be completed and signed by an authorized representative of the mare's boarding farm BEFORE arrival at the shed. PLEASE DO NOT USE SHOW SHEEN/ETC. ON THE MARES

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. DOMESTIC MAIDEN (U.S. & CANADA) A negative aerobic (regular) uterine culture is required before the initial 2013 cover. Maidens must be jumped BEFORE arrival at the shed. A negative uterine culture is required if returning from the third heat cycle on.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. DOMESTIC BARREN (and mares not bred in 2012) A negative aerobic uterine culture is required for the initial cover and if returning for a third or subsequent heat cycle.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. DOMESTIC FOALING (Foaling date \_\_\_\_\_). No tests required for the initial cover. Mares returning for a third or subsequent heat cycle must have a negative uterine culture. No foal heat doubles. Foal heat mares and doubles may be bumped at short notice.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. IMPORTED MAIDEN Refer to breeding requirements for CEM cultures on reverse side of this form. Please jump all maidens before arrival at the breeding shed.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. IMPORTED BARREN & FOALING (Date Foaled \_\_\_\_\_) Contact the state Veterinarian's Office in Frankfort, KY. regarding testing procedures and acquisition of quarantine release for the 2011 breeding season. A copy of the quarantine release **MUST** accompany the mare on her first trip to the breeding shed. A negative uterine culture is required for barren mares before the initial cover and for all mares returning for a third cycle.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. RETURN COVER A negative (regular) culture is required if returning for the third heat cycle and all subsequent cycles.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. DOUBLE No foal heat doubles. Foal heats and doubles may be bumped at short notice.

## IMPORTED MARES

MAIDEN MARES OVER 731 DAYS OF AGE AT TIME OF IMPORTATION  
MARES IMPORTED UNDER A RACING PERMIT  
MARES IMPORTED FROM COUNTRIES NOT KNOWN TO BE AFFECTED WITH CEM

These mares are not routinely quarantined by The Division of Animal Health. However, they must meet the following testing and treatment requirements prior to entering a Kentucky breeding shed.

OBTAIN A SET OF SWABS FROM THE CLITORAL FOSSA AND CLITORAL SINUSES ON DAY ONE, FOUR, AND SEVEN. MAIDENS REQUIRE TWO SETS OF CEM CULTURES WITH A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS BETWEEN THEM

ONE OF THESE SETS OF CULTURES SHALL BE OBTAINED WHILE THE MARE IS IN EARLY ESTRUS, AT WHICH TIME THE ENDOMETRIUM OF THE UTERUS SHALL ALSO BE CULTURED FOR CEM.

THE NEXT THREE (3) MARES BRED TO THE SAME STALLION AFTER THE IMPORTED MARE ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A C.F. BLOOD TEST TAKEN 15 TO 25 DAYS POST-BREEDING. COPIES OF THESE RESULTS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO ASHFORD IN A TIMELY MANNER.

## IMPORTED FOALING AND BARREN MARES

ALL FOREIGN MARES IMPORTED INTO KENTUCKY UNDER THE STATE/FEDERAL CO-OPERATIVE AGREEMENT DATED DECEMBER 18, 1981 WILL BE CONSIDERED AS "IMPORTED MARES" AND ALL REQUIREMENTS SHALL APPLY TO SAME. A COPY OF THE QUARANTINE RELEASE MUST ACCOMPANY THE MARE ON INITIAL COVER.

IMPORTED (All foreign mares not previously bred in the USA or CANADA during 2005) and QUARANTINED MARES require;

- A. Non-Pregnant      QUARANTINE RELEASE/Negative endometrium CEM culture
- B. Pregnant          QUARANTINE RELEASE/Negative endometrium CEM culture

Any mare imported since January 1, 1976 that has not been previously qualified for cover in KENTUCKY will be bred last in line and will be prophylactically scrubbed before being covered.

THE FIRST THREE (3) MARES BRED TO THE SAME STALLION FOLLOWING AN IMPORTED MARE MUST HAVE A CF TEST. Proof that the CF blood test has been drawn MUST accompany ALL mares in these categories if returning to the shed for a second cover and CF test results MUST be provided if returning for a third cover. CF test results must be furnished to the State Veterinarian's Office. CF test results are mandatory if a mare needs a double on her second heat. Mares WILL NOT be bred on a third heat without CF test results. Please submit copies of the results of this testing to Ashford Stud when received.

**\*\*\*\* PLEASE NOTE FOR THE 2013 BREEDING SEASON ALL MARES PRESENTED TO THE OAK LODGE BREEDING SHED WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A SIGNED VETERINARY STATEMENT INDICATING THAT THEY HAVE BEEN VACCINATED AGAINST EQUINE HERPES VIRUS TYPE -1, FROM 7 - 90 DAYS PRIOR TO BREEDING\*\*\*\***
